The Saskatchewan Association of Rehabilitation Centres is pleased to present, with the assistance of provincial training dollars, Great Supervision Level 2 at a reduced rate to SARC Member Agencies and CLSD-funded CBOs.

In 2010, the Recruitment & Retention committee provided a no-cost training opportunity to Agencies and brought you all three levels of the Great Supervision series. In November, provincial training funds brought Great Supervision Level 1 to Moose Jaw and North Battleford at a reduced rate.



To follow up, we are pleased to offer Level 2 to Agencies. There is a \$50 registration fee (the standard fee for this training is \$350 per Learner) to help offset the costs of the meals and refreshments.
