



BASIC SKILLS TRAINING LEARNER BURSARY

Thanks to Provincial Training Funds, SARC is pleased to offer bursaries to SARC Member Agencies of \$250 each to help offset the Learner registration fee for the BST program.

2. Complete the SIAST Student Registration Form
3. Complete the Bursary Application Form (attached to this document)

IMPORTANT: Bursary forms must accompany the BST Registration forms.

Criteria:

- You must be a resident of Saskatchewan for at least 6 months in order to apply
- You must be an employee of a SARC Member Agency

Please note:

- Bursaries are limited, depending on the size of the agency (agencies can qualify for a maximum of 2, 3 or 4 bursaries per fiscal year)
- If an agency is granted a bursary and that particular Learner does not complete the BST program, the Agency will be responsible for repayment of the bursary.
- Payment is made to the Agency, not the Learner.
