Take your experience and amplify its impact to support SARC's Member network and thousands of people experiencing disability across Saskatchewan.

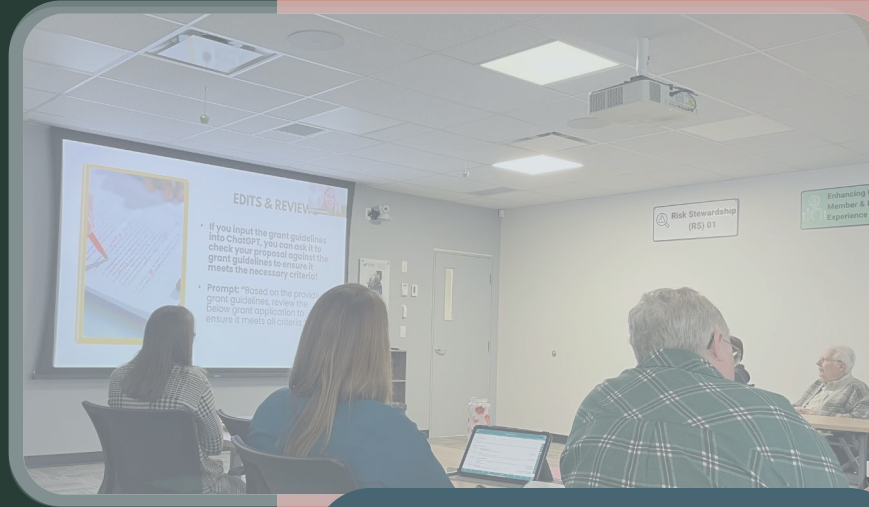


# ABOUT SARC

## THE BOARD'S ROLE

The SARC Board of Directors focuses on strategic leadership and guidance to SARC's Executive Director and Leadership Team in their work to support and strengthen the Disability Service sector and SARCAN Recycling system.



## THE FINE PRINT

### Eligibility:

SARC Regular and Associate Member Board Directors and Executive Directors - please refer to Board position nomination packages for specific details.

Note: As per SARC's bylaws, at no time shall there be two or more Directors on the SARC Board who are employees and/or sitting Board Directors of the same Member organization.

### Terms:

SARC Board Directors may serve 3 terms of 3 years each, for a total maximum of 9 years (must be re-elected from term to term).

# THE COMMITMENT

The SARC Board typically meets 8 times per year with a Friday-Saturday format:

- Friday afternoon – Board committee meetings (each Board Director will serve on 1 of the Board’s standing committees – Finance/Pension and Benefits, Member Services, SARCAN)
- Saturday morning – Board meeting



# OPTIONS FOR VIRTUAL PARTICIPATION

The SARC Board is comfortable meeting both in-person at the SARC Office in Saskatoon and virtually, and virtual participation is always an option for Directors based on time/travel availability and individual schedules.

Meetings can be joined virtually, and all Directors have a tablet courtesy of SARC so that you can access Board packages and materials in advance of meetings from anywhere you are.
